### How to reach Hamar from Oslo Airport Gardermoen

The train station (Oslo Airport Gardermoen) is located at the airport (2 minutes walk), floor below the arrival hall. Please take a train in direction Lillehammer or Trondheim (<u>not</u> in **direction Oslo**) to get to Hamar from the airport. The train leaves once every hour from Gardermoen and the trip takes approximately one hour. The price is NOK 153 (appr.  $\leq 20$ ) per person one way.

In Hamar, taxi is the most suitable way to go to the Scandic Hotel. The price will be around  $15 \in$ 

For the departure for the train station on Friday 24 June, taxis will be pre-booked (but not pre-paid) and wait outside the hotel as from 13:30.
