Why a Five-year rolling work plan for TEN-T?



From a patchwork to a network: Need to improve <u>regional level</u> planning and prioritisation

TEN-T in Western Balkans – where are we now?




TEN-T standards compliance:

- Varies significantly between transport modes
- Is <u>uneven</u> between various criteria for the same transport mode
- Particularly <u>low</u> for key criteria like ERTMS, train length, alternative fuels, ITS or road safety



TEN-T in Western Balkans – where are we now?





Key challenges:

- Core Network to be completed by <u>2030</u>, Comprehensive by <u>2050</u>
- <u>Major infrastructure upgrades</u> and <u>better</u> maintenance needed to reach TEN-T compliance
- <u>Horizontal criteria</u> requiring <u>EU acquis</u> implementation and <u>institutional reforms</u>

TEN-T in Western Balkans – where are we heading to?



77 TEN-T transport projects in the Single Project Pipelines still lacking funding > € 22.5 billion:



2 Seaports (> € 26.3 million)



43 Roads (> € 14.28 billion)



4 Inland Waterways (> € 245.9 million)



26 Railway (> € 7.84 billion)




2 Airports (> € 138.4 million)

TEN-T in Western Balkans – the challenges




Building the TEN-T Network of the future requires:

Institutional and policy reforms








Green & digital transformation

- Update SPPs in order to reflect green and digital elements
- Align national transport strategies to the green
 & digital transition




Safe and sustainable transport program



Small scale projects identified as regional priorities in TCT 5 year rolling plan

€ 80 million earmarked by the EC for small scale projects tackling:

- Border crossings on the TEN-T Network
- Safety improvements on level crossing and high-risk road sections
- Deployment of Sustainable and Smart Mobility solutions in the Western Balkans



Safe and sustainable transport program



Request for expression of interest and project proposals sent by EC in early May



5 of 6 Regional Partners have already replied positively



88 project proposals > € 400 million
